

# Official Game Rules

We are holding a standard festival charity raffle where chances are sold and placed into a raffle bin. Each chance has the name and phone number of the purchaser written on it. After all chances have been collected, we will hold a random drawing to choose one chance out of the raffle bin. The buyer of that chance, as indicated by the name and phone number, is the winner of the raffle of \$5,000 cash to be paid by St. Joseph Church. This drawing is to be held approximately at 9:45 PM Sunday July 17, 2011. The winner need not be present for this \$5,000 prize.

However, if the winner is present, then that winner gets one chance to play a Lucky Envelope contest. For this contest, the winner will be presented with 100 identical, unmarked, and opaque envelopes. One envelope will contain a winning message indicating \$20,000 has been won. 99 envelopes will not be winning envelopes. If the winner of the raffle chooses the one winning envelope, that winner will be awarded \$20,000 (in addition to the \$5,000 raffle prize noted in the prior paragraph.) The \$20,000 cash prize, if won, will be paid for via filing a claim on the Prize Indemnity Insurance policy. When received from the insurance company, the church will then issue a \$20,000 check (less applicable withholding taxes) to the winner.

If the \$5,000 raffle winner is not present between 9:45 PM and 10:00 PM Sunday July 17, 2011 to play the Lucky Envelope contest, then the contest expires and no one is allowed a chance to play for the \$20,000.

The \$5,000 raffle winner Contestant will be asked to provide a valid form of government id matching the name on the main award winning ticket before being allowed to play the Lucky Envelope contest. In the event the Contestant cannot provide a valid form of government id, the Lucky Envelope contest can continue with the contingency that verification of the Contestant's identity be provided as soon as practicable in the event the winning envelope is selected.

## Definitions:

"Contestant" means the eligible participant that has been selected in accordance with the Official Rules.

"Winning Envelope" means the one (1) and ONLY one (1) envelope out of the 100 envelopes in the Promotion that will contain the \$20,000 winning message.

"Promotion" means the St. Joseph's Church \$20,000 Envelope Draw Contest.

"Official Rules" means the rules for the St. Joseph's Church \$20,000 Envelope Draw Contest.

## Conditions:

1. There shall be no more than one (1) attempt in all at picking one (1) of the 100 envelopes.
2. The Contestant must have no prior knowledge or indication as to which of the 100 envelopes is the Winning Envelope until after he/she has made the selection.
3. Only one (1) out of the 100 envelopes will contain the \$20,000 winning message. The ninety-nine (99) other envelopes will NOT contain the winning message.
4. 100 sealed envelopes shall be prepared for the attempt, along with a master envelope that identifies which envelope has the \$20,000 winning message.
5. The envelopes must remain sealed until after the Contestant has made his/her selection. If a Contestant successfully opens the one (1) envelope with the winning message, then the ninety-nine (99) other sealed envelopes AND the master envelope must remain sealed and returned to a festival committee representative immediately. **All must be sealed.**
6. If the Contestant fails to pick the one (1) envelope with the \$20,000 winning message, then the master envelope can be opened to reveal which envelope had the winning message. That envelope along with any other envelopes may be opened.
7. The entire selection process of the envelope by the Contestant shall be videotaped in its entirety, and such videotape shall be uninterrupted.
8. The Contestant must adhere to the Official Rules.

## Claiming the \$20,000 Prize:

1. As soon as is practicable, the following items must be turned over to a festival committee representative before the prize claim will be submitted for payment:
  - a. a copy of the videotape showing the winning drawing by the Contestant (taken by the festival committee);
  - b. a signed affidavit from the potential winning Contestant attesting to his/her eligibility and compliance with the Official Rules of the game;
  - c. The 99 sealed envelopes and Master envelope.
